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JUDGING PROCEDURES

MARSHALLING AREA

On Railway Avenue between the C.N. Station and the Provincial Government building from 6:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.

JUDGING TIME AND PLACE

Judging will be during the Parade on Main Street.
Placing will be announced at the Fall Fair and in The Interior News
Entry number must be prominently displayed on the front left side of the float.

PARADE ROUTE

Commences at the traffic loop at the junction of Alfred Street and Main Street.
Route travels down Main Street, crosses Highway 16 up to 8th Avenue where it turns left to pass in front of the Hospital. The parade disbands in the church parking lot at the corner of 8th Ave. and Columbia Dr.

PARADE DISBURSEMENT

Parking lot of Christian Reformed Church at **1471 Columbia Dr.** Support workers and pickup vehicles are encouraged to park on the 7th Ave. side of the Christian Reformed Church to allow space for arriving floats on 8th Ave. and Columbia Dr. parking area.

CANDY

CANDY CANNOT BE THROWN FROM FLOATS. Please ensure everyone in your entry is aware of this rule. It can encourage spectators to run onto the parade route and/or cause injury. Should you wish to distribute candy, balloons or other items to the crowd, include someone in your entry that will walk on foot along the edge of the parade route and hand out the items. Thank you for your cooperation.

LIVESTOCK/HORSES

Please ensure that you have your own 'clean up' crew to follow behind you during the entire parade. It is important to the Fair, the Town and to the parade goers that the streets are left clean after the parade is over. Thank you.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded in all categories. Winners will be posted at the Fall Fair office, in the Interior News, and announced on The Peak Radio. All youth entries will be awarded participation prizes.
