Cakes: should have a flat or slightly rounded top, moist, fine grained, slightly glossy



surface, fine velvety texture. Does not crumble significantly when cut is tender. Has a characteristic, pleasant flavor.

Muffins: should be lightly browned, symmetrical, bumpy rough surface. Tiny holes, not tunnels.

Yeast Breads: should have smooth rounded top, evenly browned, thin crusts, moist interior, fine, even interior texture, light pleasant taste and pleasant aroma.

Decorate only if stated.
