

your place in the class. It is NOT the responsibility of the LH Show office or the whipper-in to find the competitors.

- iii. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that he/she is wearing the CORRECT number, tack and attire for the class he/she is about to enter. Each horse/exhibitor combination will be assigned its own number. If showing multiple halter horses, it is recommended to wear your number on your hip for easy changing.
- iv. **Two minutes after the class has been called to enter the show ring, the gate will be closed and no further horses will be allowed in.**
- v. **No refunds** will be made for late arrivals to class. Please note the refund regulations.

**18. STABLING RULES:**

- i. Payment for all applicable stabling fees MUST BE received before the horse will be allowed in the barn or panel pen. Exhibitors MUST provide 2 separate cheques one for stabling/panel space and one for cleaning.
- ii. Stall fees and cleaning deposits included on the cheque/money order with entry fees will have a **\$25 office fee** applied against the refund.
- iii. Stallions must be in box stalls and have priority for same.
- iv. Mares with foals are 2<sup>nd</sup> priority for box stalls.
- v. Out of town horses have 3<sup>rd</sup> priority for box stalls (if their entries have been received within the entry deadline, and stabling fees have been paid in full).
- vi. We require a \$25 cleaning deposit per stall or panel space. PLEASE PROVIDE A SEPARATE CHEQUE FOR THIS FEE. It will be cashed if:
  - a) Manure, soiled bedding and leftover feed are not removed from stalls.
  - b) Clean bedding remains and is banked.
  - c) All manure & hay leftovers are not removed from panel sites.
- vii. Complaints about dirty stalls or panels may be lodged with the Barn Manager

who will charge the cleaning deposit if the complaint is upheld.

- viii. Stabling fees are \$15/day for each stall or \$10/day for each panel space (20' by 20') with up to 3 horses allowed per panel pen. **Competitors provide their own panels and put up panels only in the designated area behind the main show ring.** For your convenience, water will be provided close to that area. **BV Exhibition does not supply panels.** Competitors supply their own panels or make rental arrangements with the Smithers Feed Store 250 847 9810 (Doug or Tom).
- ix. Stabling fees will not be cashed for decorated stalls whose surface is 75% or more covered and which have an added educational display of at least 22"x28". These requirements DO NOT qualify you for the stall decorating contest (see stall decorating contest rules)
- x. **If you take a stall you weren't assigned or do not vacate your stall on time, a \$50 penalty will be charged against your payouts.**
- xi. There will be a Barn Manager on the grounds throughout the Fair to assist LIGHTas needed.
- xii. There is BV Exhibition security on premises.
- xiii. All stalls and alley ways must be cleaned before 8 a.m. each day. Alley ways must be kept clean and tidy throughout the day.

**19. PANELS:**

- i. **BV Exhibition does not supply panels.** Competitors supply their own panels or make rental arrangements with the Smithers Feed Store 250 847 9810 (Doug or Tom).
- ii. **Panel space is limited and will be awarded on a first-come/first-serve basis.** Panel space passes must be clearly visible on the panels.
- iii. Panel pens will be only allowed around the perimeter of the camping area. This will allow the users of those pens to camp close to their horses. We organize camping/panel space accordingly, in marked & numbered sites.

- iv. A minimum 3 ft gap between panel pens is needed for horse safety reasons. Horse trailers may be located between pens so riders may saddle up without taking horses into the camping area.
- v. Entries with over \$400 per family (parents and children) in class fees will be allowed to set up panel pens free of charge, in pre-established paneling areas, if they provide their own panels. This will ease pressure on stalls to benefit the majority of contestants and acknowledge the contribution of these contestants in supporting our show.

**20. STALL DECORATING CONTEST**

- i. Each day of the show after lunch and before 5 p.m., the Show Steward and Barn Manager will check stalls. Decorated stalls will be awarded points on the following basis:
  - a. **Full coverage** of available space (minimum 75%). Any safe material might be used for this (i.e. fabric, wood, wall paper, paneling sheets).
  - b. **Use of Fair Theme** - 2010 theme is "Wonders of the Bulkley Valley".
  - c. **Available Merits** such as decorative articles and use of colour.
- ii. Educational display on a horse related subject. Minimum size for the educational display is poster board size (22"x28"). The following are **not** considered part of the educational display: breeder or sales advertisements, business information, and/or records of show successes or information about the horse and/or rider. These may be displayed in addition to an educational display.
- iii. Each day, winning stalls will be marked with a ribbon and certificate before 5 p.m.
- iv. **Stall Highpoint:** A prize of \$100 will be awarded to the stall with the highest point allocation over the four days of the show. The winner will be announced by 2 p.m. on Sunday afternoon with the cheque mailed after the show.

**21. DISEASES & LAMENESS:**

- i. All horses exhibited must be free from contagious diseases and sound. The
